



## DATA PROTECTION PROVISIONS

Where there is a possibility of entering personal or business data (e-mail addresses, names, postal addresses) on the website, this data is expressly provided by the user on a voluntary basis. Insofar as technically possible and reasonable, the services offered can be used and paid for also without providing this data or by providing anonymised data or a pseudonym. Third parties are prohibited to use the contact data published under the impressum or similar information, such as postal addresses, telephone and fax numbers as well as e-mail addresses, in order to send information that is not expressly requested, unless Schwabe & Baer Entwicklungs GmbH gave its prior written consent or a business relationship already exists. The right is expressly reserved to take legal steps against senders of what are known as spam e-mails in the event of any violation of this prohibition. Schwabe & Baer Entwicklungs GmbH and all the persons named on this website hereby object to any commercial use and disclosure of their data.

Schwabe & Baer Entwicklungs GmbH expressly points out that the transmission of data in the Internet (e.g. communications by e-mail) entail security gaps and cannot be completely protected from access by third parties.

Each time a user accesses the website of Schwabe & Baer Entwicklungs GmbH and each time a file is retrieved, data is temporarily saved and processed on this procedure in a journal file.

In particular, the following data is stored on each access/retrieval:

- \* Anonymised IP address
- \* Date and time
- \* Page retrieved/name of the file retrieved
- \* Quantity of data transmitted
- \* Message of whether access/retrieval was successful.

This data is evaluated merely for statistical purposes and to improve the website and is subsequently deleted. The data is not used in any other manner or disclosed to third parties.

When retrieving individual pages, what are known as temporary cookies are used in order to facilitate navigation. These session cookies do not contain any personal data and expire after the end of the session. Techniques, for example Java Applets or Active-X-Controls, which enable the access behaviour of users to be traced are not used.
